


### Happy New Year to all our member 'Stars'

#### Message from Ken:

At 99.7 Bridge FM, it takes a proud tream of volunteers to fill several roles that make 'the magic' happen. It's not just the voices you hear on-air. So many people work tirelessly behind the scenes - every day. Apart from the operation team in their respective admin roles, there are a bunch of others who support the announcers in areas like copywriting, news, production, research, program content. They are the silent ones whose talent adds a professional edge to what you hear on the radio. Each year, we recruit and train > a dozen people to fill those roles as well as on-air broadcasting. The initial training is a six week course, once a week: an "Introduction To Radio Broadcasting", followed by on the job training for those who make the grade.

Not everyone who completes the course will make it as an on air announcer with a limited number of air shifts available.

At the end of the course we will select and offer them to those that we believe will be the best fit. The course covers announcing, community news, programs producing, off-air production, research and more. These are all roles we are also keen to fill this year.

99.7 Bridge FM is growing and we are keen to get the best people from our community to assist in taking the station onward and upward. 
# Join the fun this Sunday 28 January 12-5pm Deception Bay Club, 32 Bayview Tce, D'Bay
